Club Getaway.

Lynn Harrington called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.

Planning for Haunted Drive Through Event: Walk Through of Club Getaway: Subcommittee members  
walked the roadway loop at Club Getaway, looking at potential sites for haunted stations and stand-  
alone props for a Halloween haunted drive-through event on October 30, 6-8 or 9 p.m. Club Getaway  
would provide:

- Use of the property, following the driveway and around the loop
- Uplighting on trees
- Fog machine
- Access to electricity and extension cords
- Some Halloween props and/or decorations
- Set-up could start Thursday evening and/or all-day Friday

Continued discussion of 2020 Halloween Activities: Subcommittee members reiterated details of the  
haunted drive-through event:

Sign-up would be through Eventbrite and would include a waiver form.

The event needs a name. Suggestions were The Drive Boo, The Boo Through, Camp Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> and  
incorporating the pandemic in the name. No decision was made.

There was discussion about the number of cars per time slot. The property could accommodate groups  
of 5-10 cars every 15 minutes. No decision was made. Cars would need to be guided in and out of the  
entryway at the lower parking lot because it is one lane. Drivers would be asked to keep on just the car's  
parking lights when they reach the start of the haunted drive-through.

There is interest in setting up a station by the Kent Land Trust, Kent Lions Club, possibly Kent School  
would drop off a station. Ms. Ferris has posted notice on Facebook for groups, businesses to create  
stations, for volunteer help and donation of Halloween props.

There also was continued discussion about handing out candy at the end of the drive. Ms. Symonds  
volunteered to purchase the candy. We could ask number of children in the cars through Eventbrite.

Ms. Manes will send out an aerial map of the property that could assist with drawing stations.

Next subcommittee meeting date: The subcommittee agreed to meet Oct. 14, 2020 at 7 p.m.

Mrs. Harrington made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 4:06 p.m.
