Jordan Palmer is doing fine. He is picking up the daily routine of testing and sampling well.

We are using one effluent bed currently. One is clean and ready to go, the other two are drying for cleanout.

The CAT generator at the plant had the necessary repairs done by HO Penn. Replacement of thermostat and cooling system flush as well as a new fuel gauge. HO Penn saved us about \$350 over Kinsley.

Speaking of Kinsley, they performed last service of the maintenance contract on both the Judd Ave and the plant generator. The contract is up for renewal. HO Penn is drawing up a proposal as well as Kinsley.

Between November 9th and the 16th installation of the belt press will begin. Work on the footings for the pump shed is in progress by Bill Gawel.

10 North Street grease trap is in the process of being installed. There is an issue of vacuum testing that is currently being rectified.
