Septage Lagoons:

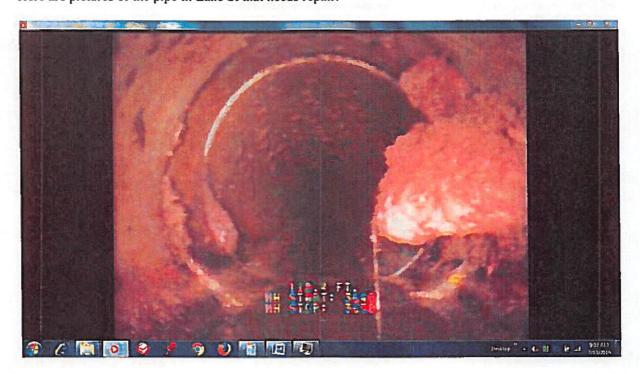
Replacement decant Valve was order and, finally, received. Additional parts were ordered and are expected soon. We are working with the Superintendent to schedule a date to install.

Septage Lagoon 1 was cleaned and assistance was provided during this process.

N. Main St Sewer Inspection:

Berkshire Industrial Services was contacted concerning the inspection. They felt that another contractor could be better suited to inspect the 6" diameter line that has bends in it. So, New England Pipe Cleaning Company was contacted. They indicate that the line can be inspected with their equipment. They can also perform the repair on Lane Street can be performed. If the inspection and repair are scheduled at the same time, the can both be done for approximately \$4,000. They will prepare a proposal, if the Commission wishes to move ahead.

Here are pictures of the pipe in Lane St that needs repair:





Monitoring Reports and Daily Operation Logs

A finished draft of the reporting form was completed and it will be used for the Monthly State Reports in December. The Daily Reports should help more information be collected and recorded. The Daily Reports will also provide a list of the tasks that need to be done regularly.

Asset Management Program (CUPSS):

This free program from USEPA has an acceptable Operation and maintenance scheduler but other aspects of the program are not very useful compared with paid for programs, i.e. development of capital management plan and budgeting. Even with its limitations, this program could work in combination with the Daily Operations logs. Further discussion and review with the Chief operator.

Aeration Project
