#### KENT SEWER COMMISSION - DRAFT MINUTES - January 13, 2015

Present: John Casey, Chairman; Susi Williams, Elissa Potts, Virginia Bush-Suttman, Sal Lilienthal.

Also present: Plant Superintendent John Walsh, Collector Deborah Devaux, Bart Clerk (Oakwood).

Mr. Casey called the regular meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. **Elevate alternates:** 

Mr. Casey elevated alternates Virginia Bush-Suttman and Sal Lilienthal to voting status.

Agenda: The agenda was approved as presented.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes of December 9, 2014 were approved as written on a motion by Susi Williams, seconded by Virginia Bush-Suttman; so voted unanimously.

Public communications: There were no public oral or written communications.

#### Report of Chairman:

- Mr. Casey read a letter from William R. Tobin, Jr., tendering his resignation from the Sewer Commission effective January 2015. Mr. Tobin has served on the Commission since its inception, including several years as chairman. Virginia Bush-Suttman moved to accept Mr. Tobin's resignation "with deep regret and great thanks for decades of service." Susi Williams seconded; so voted unanimously. There was discussion about filling the vacancy; Sal Lilienthal, alternate, will consider the position.
- As mentioned in December, Mr. Casey noted the need for a Benefit Assessment Committee for the properties on Maple Street Extension. Members will include attorney Jeff Sienkiewicz and Consultant Bart Clark of Oakwood Environmental Associates. Elissa Potts and Susi Williams volunteered to serve with them. Mr. Casey will arrange a meeting of the Committee. Deborah Devaux, Collector, would like to sit in on meetings in order to learn the process.
- The Ordinance Committee to update our Sewer Ordinance will be named at the February meeting. Mr. Casey will serve on that committee.

#### **Report of Superintendent:**

- Mr. Walsh reported that 1.73 million gallons went through the plant.
- The testing of water at the plant revealed that the water is "okay".
- Quarterly reporting, with assistance from Joe Traski of LEA, will begin at the end of the month.
- The locking of the gates is "going fine".

#### Report of the Treasurer:

• Jennifer Weigel presented the Check Detail for the month, as well as the Balance Sheet as of December 31, 2014 and the Budget vs. Actuals. Virginia Bush-Suttman made a motion to approve the Check Detail report; Susi Williams seconded; so voted unanimously.

#### Report of the Collector:

• Deborah Devaux presented the Rate Book Balance Sheet report of delinquents from 2011 (\$0) through 2014, showing a balance of uncollected taxes of \$9385.29.

#### **New Business:**

- Bart Clark of Oakwood Environmental Associates presented a preliminary report of a Capital Projects list, with all costs shown as "conceptual order of magnitude" which "will have to be revised once more data is obtained". The comprehensive list includes projects to be done within 5 years, 5 to 10 years, and more than 10 years in future. The projects will be reviewed and prioritized for the first 5 years, and the projects can be updated annually. Unknown at the moment is what new requirements that a revised discharge permit may place on plant operations and what improvements may be needed to meet those requirements. The preliminary report shall become attached to these minutes.
- Maple Street Ext. Financing nothing new to report.
- Benefits Assessment see above in Mr. Casey's report.
- Sewer Commission resignation and appointment of replacement see above in Mr. Casey's report. As Mr. Tobin was an elected Democrat, the Democratic Town Committee will be consulted as a matter of courtesy. Replacement members are not required to be of any particular political party.
- Ordinances Committee to be named in February.

- Job Descriptions to be addressed at next meeting
- LEA Proposal for Sampling and Reporting see report of Superintendent.

Re: Preliminary Capital Projects List

The Sewer Commission is developing a significant balance in its Short Lived Capital Assets and Capital Reserve Accounts. The Commission had an interest in understanding what large projects/equipment purchases are expected in the next 5 years, 5-10 yr, and more than 10 yr periods. This memo starts a list of projects for the Commission's consideration.

Once a list of potential capital projects has been assembled, the Commission can consider prioritizing the projects in the first five years and putting conceptual costs estimates on the project. The Capital Project Plan can be updated every year to take projects off that are completed and add new projects. All cost currently shown are conceptual "order of magnitude" and will have to be revised once more data is obtained to more closely estimate the project costs.

Some projects will not be able to be foreseen. The biggest question mark at the moment is what new requirements that a revised discharge permit will place on the plant operations and what improvements may be needed to meet these requirements.
