

MINUTES OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING - Continued

Be it further resolved that approval is given by the town meeting to such discontinuance and abandonment by the selectmen under the provisions of Section 13a-49 Connecticut General Statutes at a meeting of the Selectmen after the date hereof.

Moderator announced that a Petition had been filed under the provisions of Section 7-7, G.S. as amended, requesting that action on the abandonment of roads be submitted to the voters for a vote on the voting machines on a date and during such hours as the meeting might determine.

It was moved and seconded that the adjourned meeting be held on Saturday, March 20, 1971, from 12 noon to 8 P.M.

Arthur Newton moved that an amendment be made to add Chase Hill Road to the list of roads to be retained. Moderator ruled this motion out of order. It was pointed out by Town Attorney Wall that the vote will have no effect until the Selectmen endorse it and before that endorsement the names of additional roads could be added.

The motion to set the date of the adjourned meeting for Saturday, March 20, 1971, from 12 noon to 8 P.M. was unanimously approved.

Discussion.

Moderator announced that it having been moved and seconded that action on the abandonment of roads be approved and there having been reasonable discussion at this meeting, that the meeting would adjourn to Saturday, March 20, 1971, from 12 noon to 8 P.M. at the Town Hall in the Town of Kent for a vote on the voting machines by a "Yes" or "No" vote, a "Yes" vote being for the adoption of such motion and a "No" vote being against the adoption thereof, the procedure to be as provided in Section 7-7, G.S. as amended.
