Jean Speck called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Jean Speck started the meeting by stating that is has been an extremely hectic week and therefore, she may not be prepared to discuss some of the items on the agenda tonight. She added they took in almost 9,000 N-95 masks today.

Jean Speck called for the vote. All three voted yes and the motion carried,

<u>Parks and Rec Commission – new hire recommendation for Parks and rec</u> <u>Director:</u>

Parks and Rec Commission member Julia Neff read the motion made by the Parks and Rec Commission:

The Parks and rec Commission hereby recommends to the Board of Selectmen the hiring of Jared Kuczenski as the Town of Kent's Park and Recreation Director. The position being offered is full time (40 hours per week) with a starting annual salary of \$60,000 and the Town's current full time fringe benefit package. The duties of the position are outlined in the Parks and Recreation Director Job Description. Employment start date to be mutually agreed upon between Town and Jared Kuczenski.

Jean Speck made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss the recommendation made by the Parks and Rec Commission and invited Lynn Harrington, Julia Neff and Joyce Kearns at 4:14 p.m. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Jean Speck made a motion to come out of Executive Session at 5:09 p.m. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion. Jean Speck and Glenn Sanchez voted yes. Rufus DeRham abstained. The motion carried.

Jean Speck stated no action taken, a special BoS meeting will be schedule for Monday, January 10, 2022 at 11:00a.m.

<u>Transfer Station Manager – new hire recommendation for Transfer Station</u> Attendant:

Rick Osborne stated that he did not receive any responses to the advertisement for the Transfer Station Attendant. A prior employee reached out to Rick Osborne to stated he will be moving back to CT and potential could fill the position. Jean Speck would like to repost the position.

Highway Department - new hire recommendation for CDL Maintainer:

Rick Osborne stated Robert Taylor, who was offered and accepted the CDL Maintainer position decided to take a position in another town. Rick Osborne recommended Luke Belletti be hire to fill the vacant CDL Maintainer position starting at \$30.85 per hour.

Jean Speck made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss the Highway Foreman's recommendation for the CDL Maintainer position and invited Rick Osborne and Joyce Kearns at 5:11 p.m. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Jean Speck made a motion to come out of Executive Session at 5:19 p.m. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Jean Speck made a motion to hire Luke Belletti as the CDL Maintainer at the hourly rate of \$30.85 with a start date of January 10, 2022. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Town Meeting Agenda Approval:

Glenn Sanchez:

Board of Selectmen Resolution regarding meeting recordings:

Jean Speck made the following motion:

The BoS resolves that each municipal board and commission, or any subcommittee thereof, shall video record all such meetings and proceedings. If video capabilities are not available, all meetings and proceedings must be audio recorded. Recordings shall be sent to the Town Clerk, to be posted on the town's website not later than seven days after the meeting. This resolution shall take effect immediately and is in addition to filing requirements of meeting minutes in accordance with the CT FOI Act.

Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion.

Jean Speck called for discussion:

 Donna Hayes asked that the motion include: "and any applicable CT General Statutes."

Jean Speck made a motion to add: and any applicable CT General Statutes. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Darlene Brady asked how the information would get out to all boards and commissions? Jean Speck responded, "my office".

Jean Speck called for a vote on the motion. All three selectmen voted yes. The motion carried.

Medic 4 contract – possible Executive Session:

Jean Speck made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss the Medic 4 contract at 5:39 p.m. Glenn Sanchez seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Jean Speck made a motion to come out of Executive Session at 5:54 p.m. Rufus deRham seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Jean Speck noted this item will remain on the agenda for additional updates.

Zoom meeting protocol:

Rufus deRham asked how a ballot vote works on Zoom? Jean Speck advised him that polls are created prior to the meeting.

Discussion of possible WIFI at the Swift House and the Community House:

Glenn Sanchez recused himself from the discussion. Jean Speck reviewed the attached emails from the Chamber in which they requested internet service in the Swift House. Zanne Charity agreed that WIFI should be at the Swift House and Community House. Joyce Kearns confirmed with Spectrum that each location would be \$119 per month with a onetime fee of \$99 for installation. Jean Speck stated she needs to confirm with Yucatech regarding municipal access to the internet. She requested this item be hold-off until the next meeting.

Town Hall large meeting room videoconference system update:

Glenn Sanchez reviewed the two proposals for video equipment in the large meeting room and compared prices. He would like to look at the large meeting room and talk with town hall staff. He had several questions:

- Town Hall or Community House?

Donna Hayes stated that the Community House would not work for the commissions she represents. She stated there is too much paperwork that she needs access to during a meeting and bringing it all to the Community House would not be feasible.
