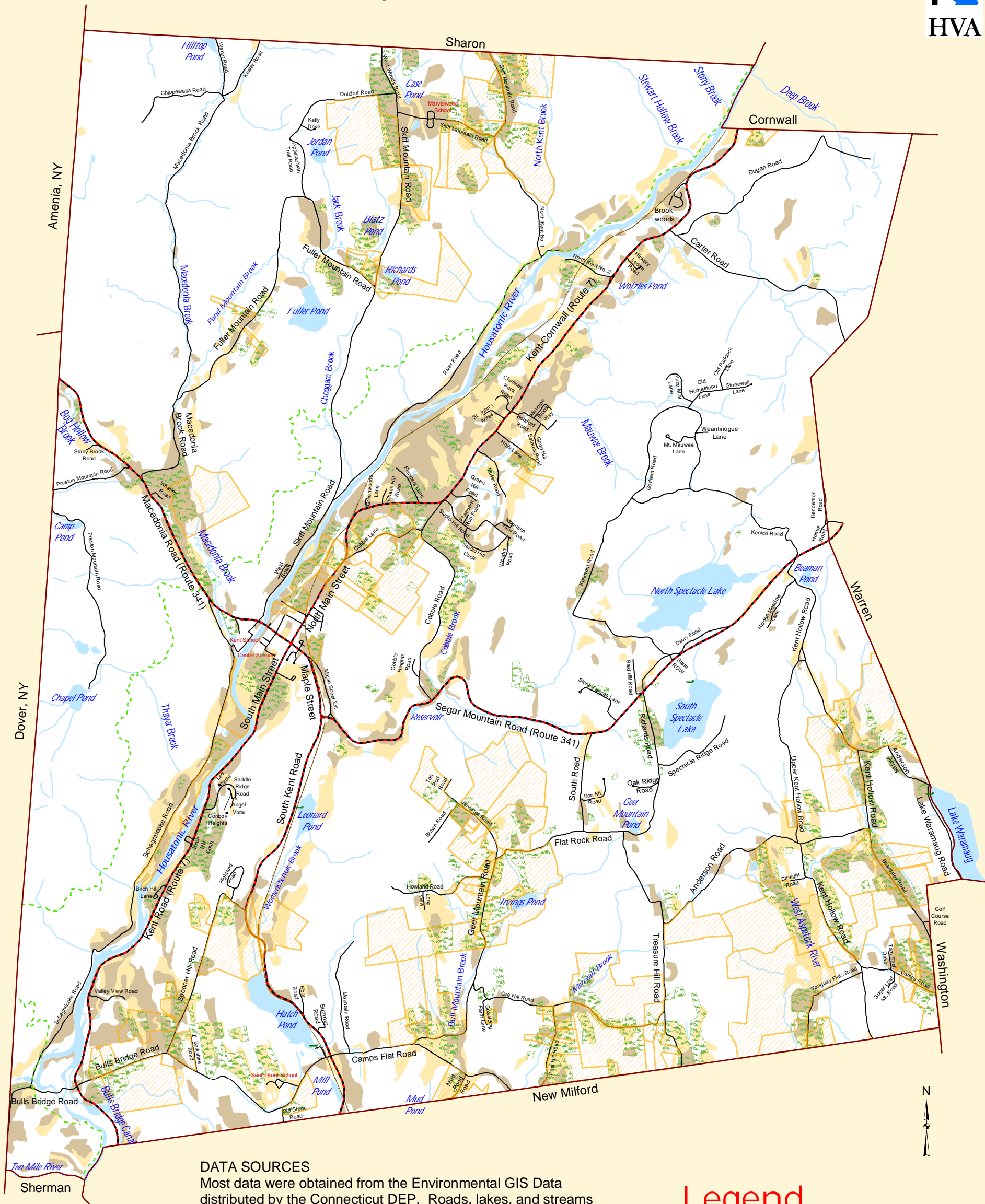

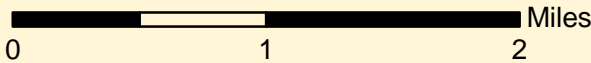


### DATA SOURCES

Most data were obtained from the Environmental GIS Data distributed by the Connecticut DEP. Roads, lakes, and streams are based on USGS DLG files. Road data were enhanced through the use of GPS, digital orthophotos, and town review. The Appalachian Trail was obtained through the use of a GPS receiver with 2-5 meter positional accuracy. Farm land was digitized from the 2004 orthophotos from the Connecticut DEP web site. Farm soils are from the USDA digital soil survey.
