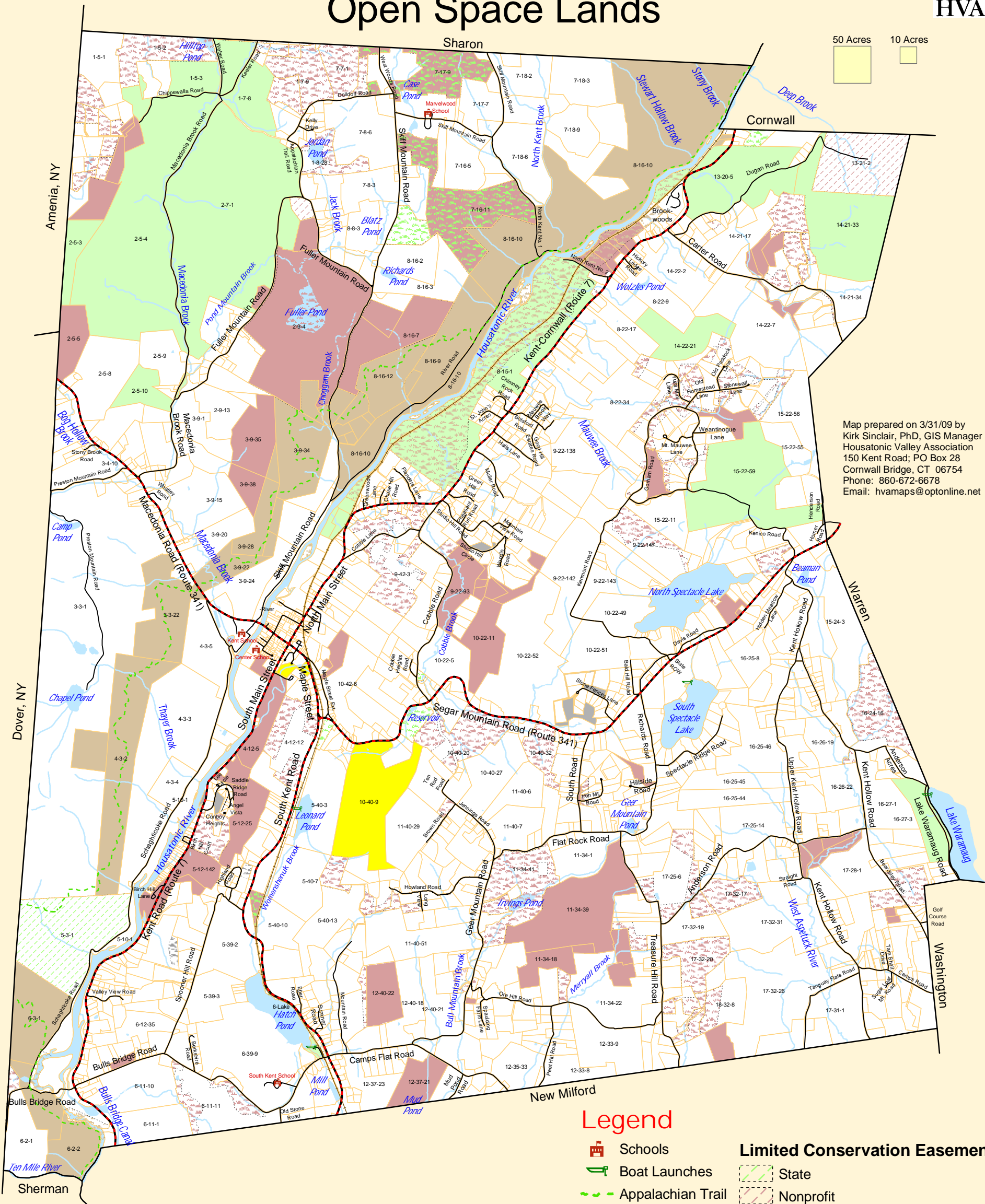

13. Permanently Protected Open Space Lands

Most data were obtained from the Environmental GIS Data distributed by the Connecticut DEP. Roads are based on USGS DLG files and enhanced through the use of GPS, digital orthophotos, and town review. The Appalachian Trail was obtained through the use of a GPS Receiver.

Protected lands were compiled by HVA from the town of Kent's tax assessor's office, with assistance from the Kent Land Trust and the Kent Conservation Commission. Parcel boundaries were digitized from tax assessor's maps with an RMS <= 0.003. This map is updated through December 2008 by the Kent Conservation Commission. Conservation easement lands are privately owned, and not open to the public.

This map is not to be construed as an accurate survey and is subject to change
