

News Worth Sharing: Please take the Sidewalk Materials Survey

One of the biggest projects in Kent's history is finally going to come to fruition and we want to hear from the community!

The Town is ready to move forward with Phase I of the Streetscape Project, which uses a \$500,000 grant from the CT Department of Transportation Community Connectivity Grant Program. This phase involves replacing the sidewalks on North Main Street (aka Route 7), as well as Bridge Street (aka Route 341) to the bridge.

- The survey is limited to one response per device.


We look forward to sharing the results of the survey at the April 7th Board of Selectmen meeting.
