

News Worth Sharing: Holiday Hours & Helpful Reminders for using the Transfer Station

December 23, 2021

Holiday Hours

Town Hall:

- Thursday, December 23 and Thursday, December 30: closed at noon
- Friday, December 24 and Friday, December 31: closed all day

Transfer Station:

- Saturday, December 25 and Saturday, January 1: closed
- Sunday, December 26 and Sunday, January 2: open extended hours (8:ooa 4:3op)

Helpful reminders from the Transfer Station Crew:

- The Town of Kent pays different rates for the disposal of materials from the transfer station.
 - Municipal Solid Waste/ Household Garbage: \$95.83 per ton
 - Recyclables: \$10.00 per ton
- Please be mindful about what is going in the Recycling Bin. When the Recycling Bin is too full of non-accepted items, it gets billed as Household Garbage at a significantly higher rate.
- All items going into the Recycling Bin must be to be empty and rinsed or wiped out, including glass. Please note that the most common contamination is food and liquid.
- Pet food cans and plastic containers should be rinsed. Cans can also be put in the Metal Bin.
- The list of acceptable and non-acceptable items for recycling changes from time to time (see link below). Currently, black plastic, paper towels, face tissues, tissue paper, and gift wrap all are Household Garbage.
- Old or moldy cardboard and paper and cardboard with paint or oil on it is also Household Garbage.
- Items under 2" may not go in the Recycling Bin except paper rolls with no paper left on them.
- Items must be separated. Please DO NOT nest items (ie: put them inside one another).

- Sorting is done by optical scanners along conveyor belts. Mixed items cannot be identified and become Household Garbage.
- Please keep your household recycling bins free of garbage. This saves the attendants from having to pick out items such as dryer lint, cotton swabs, food waste, gum, etc.
- Please save time by separating at home.
