
- Benefits of Reliable Wireless Service
 - 80% of all 9-1-1 calls are made from a mobile phone
 - Mobile data traffic has grown 17-fold over the past 5 years with an 82.2% increase between 2017 and 2018
 - 2018: Americans connected 421.7 million mobile devices




- AT&T's Existing Coverage Gap
 - Central Portion of Town
 - FirstNet: first broadband network dedicated to America's police, firefighters and emergency medical services
 - Kent Fire Department, Kent Town Highway Department, Kent EMS and Kent Emergency Management will install communications equipment on the new facility


















Facility will comply with all applicable health and safety standards regarding power density

Environmental: Site B: 93 Richards Rd


No impacts to wetlands approximately 500' north of proposed compound

No historic properties within 0.5 mile of area of Potential Effect


Facility not located within 0.25 miles of any Natural Diversity Database Map (NDDB) areas

Facility will comply with all applicable health and safety standards regarding power density


Viewshed Map Site A: Bald Hill Rd




Viewshed Map Site A: Bald Hill Rd
