A few notables for this week:

- With the start of Kent Center School tomorrow, please be aware of increased traffic in the area of Bridge and Elizabeth Streets between 7:45 8:30a, and again between 2:45 3:30p. Follow flagger instructions and be aware of changing traffic patterns.
- The contractor is aware of the busy Labor Day weekend coming up, and will work to make sure the construction sites are cleaned up and safe for the expected increased traffic over the weekend.

### **Two Week Look Ahead**

- Bridge Street I South Side:
  - The Finish Team is finishing up this week.
  - Repaving will be wrapping up this week.
- Bridge Street | North Side:
  - Demo work may begin the middle of this week.
- North Main Street I East Side:
  - Demo Team is wrapping up, Finish Team continues curbing install and pouring concrete.

## **What's Been Done**

- Bridge Street I South Side:
  - Demo Team has completed work
  - The Finish Team plans to have sidewalks finished to the intersection by middle of next week
  - Repaving of asphalt apron has begun.
- North Main Street | East Side:
  - Demo Team has begun and will continue southward to the railroad tracks.
     Finish Team will follow.
- North Main Street | West Side
  - Tree removal completed of two trees/shrub at St. Andrews; one tree at Chestnut Woodworking.

- The site foreman is aware of the first day of KCS tomorrow and will work with the KCS crossing guard to ensure safety of walkers and increased vehicle traffic.
- Schedule information shared is always subject to change due to weather, etc.
- This project is on the State highway and as such, the project must meet State DOT specifications. Part of those requirements include repaving out into the roadway a certain number of feet. As such, you will see some repaving.
- On any tree removals that had to take place, Bruce Bennett, Town Tree Warden, is working with property owners on replacement of the trees.
