YOU MAY VOTE AT A KENT TOWN MEETING IF:

- 1. You are an elector of the Town of Kent
- 2. You are a citizen of the United States, age eighteen or older, who, jointly or severally, is liable to the Town of Kent for taxes assessed against you on an assessment of not less than \$1,000 on the last-completed grand list of the Town

NOT ELIGIBLE TO VOTE (as they are not citizens of the United States):

- 1. Corporations, limited liability companies (LLCs), partnerships, trusts, and other legal entities
- 2. Individual(s) serving as trustee of a trust that owns property in Kent



CHAPTER 90* TOWN AND OTHER COMMUNITY MEETINGS

Sec. 7-6. Eligibility to vote. At any town meeting other than a regular or special town election, any person who is an elector of such town may vote and any citizen of the United States of the age of eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable to the town for taxes assessed against him on an assessment of not less than one thousand dollars on the last-completed grand list of such town, or who would be so liable if not entitled to an exemption under subdivision (17), (19), (22), (23), (25) or (26) of section 12-81, may vote, unless restricted by the provisions of any special act relating to such town.
