At their regular meeting held on Oct 10, 2021, the Board of Finance approved six budget transfers and of the six, only one exceeds twenty thousand dollars. The six budget transfers are listed on the reverse of this page.

At this meeting tonight, the Board of Finance is asking the town to move and act upon budget transfer number "Six" which is listed below. The total amount budgeted for this department was \$29,000 and the total expense exceeded that amount by \$45,675 principally related to the cell tower intervention. Detail of all Attorney Fees paid in FY 2020 - 2021 follows on page #1.

Enabling Legislation

State Statute: Sec7-347: The board (Board of Finance) may transfer unexpended balances from one appropriation to another, but no amount appropriated for any purpose, whether general or special, shall be used or appropriated for any other purpose unless the same is recommended by the board.

In part, State Statute: Sec7-348: reads; in towns where the grand list is more than twenty million dollars, if the amount required exceeds twenty thousand dollars, such appropriation shall not be made until, upon the recommendation of the board, the same has been voted by the town at a meeting called for such purpose.

The numbers are good on the face but we're going to see it trend towards a severe decline in enrollment if the Town doesn't enact some sort of plan to develop business opportunities that bring in families and develop housing that is affordable for those young families with children. Otherwise, we'll be paying a considerable cost to keep KCS open and functional with a large staff (mandated by State and National education dictates), a small student population, and an aging building. A good example to review would be Cornwall and Falls Village.

This is my last meeting with the BOF, thank you all for your cooperation and support and I wish you all the best.
