Kent Town Hall closing to public

[KENT, CT; 17 MARCH, 2020] — First Selectman Jean C. Speck announced Kent Town Hall is closing to the public. Ms. Speck said, "In light of the declared federal and state emergencies due to the national COVID19 pandemic, and given the widespread community transmission of this virus, I have made the decision to close Town Hall to the public beginning at noon today through Friday March 27th. Town employees have been notified and each department is evaluating and modifying operations to ensure continuity of essential government services. "

Members of the public needing to conduct business with Town of Kent departments may use the website, www.townofkentct.org, and contact staff via email or phone.

The Kent Transfer Station will continue its modified operations this weekend of self-tossing of household garbage and single-stream recycling only.

Remember that the best sources of information will be the Torrington Area Health District, the State of Connecticut Health Department's COVID 19 site and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
