INFORMATION ON ELDERLY, TOTALLY DISABLED HOMEOWNERS AND ADDITIONAL VETERANS FOR TAX CREDITS APPLICATION PERIOD FEBRUARY 1, 2019 TO MAY 15, 2019

Based on requirements set forth by the State of Connecticut, the Town of Kent offers a program for Elderly Homeowners and Totally Disabled Persons. First year applicants must apply in person to the Assessor's office no later than May 15, 2019.

Qualifying Income limit not to exceed:

Unmarried \$36,000 Married \$43,900

To qualify proof of all income needs to accompany application. Income includes a copy of your 2018 Income Tax Return; (if you file one); Social Security, wages, bonuses, taxable portion of annuities and pensions, interest dividends, net rent or proceeds from a sale of property, etc..

Veterans who are receiving an exemption under section 12-81 of the CT General Statutes may also be eligible for an additional exemption providing the same income requirements are met as outlined above.
