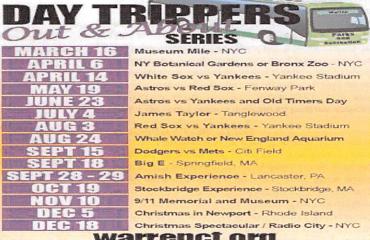

Town Business & Reminders

Renter's Rebate Program: If you are a senior 65+ or a person with a disability, and pay rent for an apartment, a cooperative, congregate housing, subsidized housing, or for a rooming house, you may be eligible for this program. The application period is April 1 to October 1, 2019. The rebate amount you may receive is based on a graduated income scale and the amount of rent and utility payments you made in the PRIOR year (2018). Income limits: single person \$36,000.00; married couple \$43,900. Those that apply must meet at least one of the following criteria: Individual or spouse must be 65 years of age or older as of December 31, 2018. Renter must be 50 years of age or older and the surviving spouse of a renter who at the time of death had qualified and was entitled to this program (provided the couple was living together at the time of death). Renter must be 18 years of age or older who is permanently and totally disabled under Social Security Disability guidelines. All Renters must have resided in the State of Connecticut for at least one year at any given time. To schedule an appointment, contact Leah Pullaro, Kent Social Services 860-927-1586.

Elderly and Totally Disabled Homeowners Program: Applications taken in the Assessor's Office from February 1, 2019 to May 15, 2019. Homeowner, or their spouse, has to be 65 years old as of December 31, 2018 and be the owner (or have life use) of the property as of October 1, 2018. If you are Social Security Totally Disabled there is no age requirement. Bring proof of income for the calendar year 2018. This includes a signed copy of your federal income tax return and the SSA-1099 Social Security form. If you do not have to file an income tax return, please bring all documents provided for 2018 income (interest, dividends, pensions, etc.). Income limits are \$36,000 for unmarried and \$43,900 for married for 2018. Income is your adjusted gross income PLUS untaxed social security benefits. Veterans who are receiving an exemption under section 12-81 of the CT General Statutes may also be eligible for an additional exemption provided the same income levels are me as outlined above. The Assessor's Office is open Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:00AM -12:00PM and 1:00PM to 4:00PM. If there are any questions you can contact the Assessor's Office at 860-927-3160.

Park Passes: Park passes will be available for the 2019-20 year beginning June 24. Pass is required to swim at Emery Park, use the tennis courts at Kent Common and participate in the holiday and winter ice skating programs. Passes cost \$35 for Kent residents; free for residents ages 65 and older. Passes may be purchased at Emery Park, 42 Segar Mountain Road, daily, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting June 24 when the park opens for seasonal swimming and in the Park and Recreation office, Town Hall, Monday-Friday (starting June 24) 9:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 3 p.m.

Salisbury VNA, beginning March 20th at 1:00p.m., offers a free blood pressure screening on the third Wednesday of each month at Kent Station Pharmacy.

Adult Coloring Program: Adult coloring for senior citizens meets monthly on the second Monday, 2-4 p.m., at the Kent Senior Center, 16 Swifts Lane. Coloring materials are provided. The program is hosted by the Kent Memorial Library, Templeton Farms and the Town of Kent.
